## Compliance Notes Around Categories

Co	ompliance Category	Rules/Expecations
1	Bullying/Harassment or Community Relationships	<ul> <li>Students are expected to treat each other with respect by communicating with others using language that is non-threatening and does not vilify any member of the community.</li> <li>Students are not to create, publish or share material about community members that can be considered threatening or vilifying in any way.</li> <li>Students are expected to report all instances of behavior that is not in accordance with the previous points.</li> </ul>
2	Teaching and Learning Rules	<ul> <li>Students are expected to respect the authority of a teacher or learning leader and comply with all learning and management instructions.</li> <li>Students are expected to learn and accept the expectation of each new learning environment before they can engage with other planned learning activities.</li> <li>Students are expected to accept responsibility for their own actions and accept the consequences according to the compliance flow chart.</li> </ul>
3	Serious Behaviour Incidents	• Any behavior that puts any community member at immediate risk to their safety will be reported to a member of the senior executive as soon as possible.
4	BYOD (including phones/ear-phones)	<ul> <li>Rules relating to the use of any electronic device in the classroom are set by the teacher. No device can be used unless instructed by a teacher.</li> <li>Students are to leave ear-phones in bags during class time unless use is instructed by a teacher.</li> <li>Mobile phones are to be switched off or on silent while on school grounds.</li> <li>Mobile phones can be used in class only if interested by a teacher.</li> <li>Receipt of, or making video or voice calls during the school day is not permitted.</li> <li>Students are not to video other students or staff without permission.</li> <li>Students are not to use Bluetooth speakers at recess or lunchtime.</li> </ul>
5	Attendance	<ul> <li>Students who truant a lesson will need to make up each minute missed with the class teacher. Students who persistently do not comply with attendance requirements will follow compliance consequences.</li> <li>Students who are truanting a whole school day will make the day up through negotiation with DP and parent.</li> <li>Students in Years 7 – 9 who fall below acceptable levels of attendance will be monitored by the Wellbeing Team.</li> <li>Students in Years 10 – 12 who fall below the acceptable levels of attendance may be N determined in one or more courses and therefore may not be permitted to continue their pattern of study.</li> </ul>
6	Uniform	<ul> <li>Students are expected to honour the school by wearing correct school uniform.</li> <li>Students should report to HT Student Support/DP before school for a uniform note if they are out of uniform</li> <li>Teachers to record students out of uniform without a pass on PXP period 1</li> <li>Head Teacher Student Support to run a uniform report each morning to be sent to HT Student Support.</li> </ul>
